International Modified Bumpjump Competition Rules

1. **Modified Bumpjumper Defined:** A single ski design, equipped with a seat where a competitor rides.
2. **Starts:** Rider shall start upon command. No running starts are allowed.
3. **Out of Bounds:** Rider shall stay within course limits, or the run will be nullified.
4. **Finish Line:** The rider must cross the finish line with the bumpjumper (either ridden or carried).
5. **Attempts:** Riders will be given only two (2) attempts to ride the course. If a fall occurs on the first attempt, the rider shall not make a second attempt until the other riders have completed their first run.
6. **Order:** Competitors shall be launched in order by number: 001,002, etc.

Race Officials: Race officials reserve the right to make adjustments prior to the start of the event to accommodate course conditions and the number of competitors involved. These adjustments include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Limit number of attempts by the competitor per race course.
2. Modify or eliminate one or more of the race courses.
3. Cancel the event if the conditions are such that it endangers the competitor or the lack of snow makes the course inoperable.

Winner Determine – Speed Run: Riders shall run speed course.
